We're responding to your request dated Feb. 23, 2026, about the tax-exempt status of 1 World Humanity Organization

We issued a determination letter in July 2025, granting this organization exemption from federal income tax under Internal Revenue Code Section (IRC) 501(c)(3).

Our records show this organization isn't a private foundation within the meaning of IRC Section 509(a) because it's described in IRC 509(a)(2).

Donors can deduct contributions to this organization as provided in IRC Section 170. Bequests, legacies, devises, transfers or gifts to the organization or for its use are deductible for federal estate and gift tax purposes if they meet the requirements of IRC Sections 2055, 2106 and 2522.

If an organization fails to file a required annual return or notice for three consecutive years, its tax-exempt status is revoked by operation of law. The revocation is effective on the filing due date of the third annual return or notice. For more information about filing requirements, you can visit [IRS.gov/EO](https://www.irs.gov/EO).
